
## POLY SNOUT SAVERS INSTRUCTIONS



## **Mounting Procedure:**

- 1. Bend Snout Saver to desired height.
- 2. Attach Snout Saver to bottom of divider directly behind point.
- 3. Use enclosed zip screws to fasten Snout Saver to divider. (see above diagram)
- 4. BE CAREFUL NOT TO OVERTIGHTEN SCREW!

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


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## POLY SNOUT SAVERS INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Tuck the narrow front end of the Snout Saver underneath the divider cap. The tip should go into the cap 1-1/2". If not, trim the edges to fit.
- 2. Adjust height of bubble by pushing or pulling back on the Snout Saver. Mark holes on the poly tip over the metal edges. Use a vise to bend the poly if too stiff to bend by hand.
- 3. Drill 3/8" holes through the metal and the poly.
- 4. Bolt the bubble tip to the divider using the supplied 3/8" bolts.





## FOR WIDE ROW SNOUT SAVERS.....

- 1. Adjust bubble height as shown above.
- 2. Slide Extension Bar between the Snout Saver and bottom of divider. Mark two (2) sets of holes in bar: an outside set to bolt the bar to the divider and an inside set to bolt the Snout Saver to the extension.
- 3. Drill 3/8" holes and bolt the divider, Snout Saver, and bar together with supplied bolts.
- 4. Cut bar edges down so it is flush with outside edge of the divider.



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
